State Secretary Eirik Owre Thorshaug of the Norwegian Ministry of Defence made his first visit to NATO's Joint Warfare Centre (JWC) on Tuesday 15 January 2013.

Before his appointment to the Ministry of Defence in 2012, Mr Thorshaug subsequently served as Political Advisor and State Secretary at the Ministry of Justice and Public Security.

On arrival to the JWC's premises in Jåttå, Stavanger, Mr Thorshaug was warmly welcomed by French Army Major General Jean Fred Berger, Commander JWC, and senior officials of the Centre.

The visit programme included a bilateral meeting with the Commander and a series of comprehensive briefings by the JWC leadership on the Centre's mission and tasks in support of the transformational goals of the Alliance, as well as on the Centre's current activities and future requirements as NATO's premier operational-level training provider. Major General Berger also briefed on the JWC Vision for 2014 and beyond.
